Bid process to host the 2025 World Amateur Team Championships

Dear Member:

The IGF is pleased to open the bidding process for the 2025 World Amateur Team Championships (WATC) to all IGF National Federation Members (NFM).

Following the vote of the 2018 Biennial Meeting, the 2025 WATC will become a one-course event per Championship with a minimum number of 36 women's teams and 36 men's teams. Information about hosting and bidding can be found in the *IGF Event Bidding Rules, 2025 WATC Application Form and the WATC Technical Manual* which can be found on the [IGF website](#).

Please find below the timeline and requirements for submitting a bid:

| 7 March 2022 | WATC bid information sent to all IGF NFMs |
| 1 April 2022 | An Expression of Interest, including the following information, is due to the IGF: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Host city- Main airport- Host course(s)- Host hotel(s)- Proposed dates- Provision financial model |
| 1 May 2022 | From among the IGF NFMs indicating interest, the IGF will select the members who are invited to submit full bids. |
| 17 June 2022 | The WATC Application Form is due from the members who were invited to submit full bids. The IGF will review the bid for completeness and work with the NFM to satisfy any remaining document requirements. |
| 1 August 2022 | The IGF will send the bidding countries' completed WATC Application Forms to all IGF NFMs. |
| 29 August 2022 | The NFMs will vote on the 2025 site during the 2022 Biennial Meeting. |
