

President

1. General Description:

The President of the IGF is appointed by the Board in accordance with Article 9 of the IGF Constitution. The President shall ex officio be a member of the Board and shall not have any vote on a resolution put to the Board unless the President has been appointed as a member of the Board. (Articles 7.5 to 7.11)

The President shall represent the IGF in such circumstances and at such events and in such manner or way, as shall be determined by the Board. (Article 9.5)

2. Responsibilities:

The specific duties of the President include but are not limited to:

- i) Representing the IGF and facilitating effective communication and relationships with IGF Member Federations, IOC, IPC, ASOIF, GAISF, sponsors and other internal and external stakeholders.
- ii) Be an ex officio non-voting member of the IGF Board and attend the IGF Biennial meeting and such meetings considered appropriate.
- iii) Attendance at the Olympic Games, Youth Olympic Games, World Amateur Team Championships, IOC Session and other official functions performing customary duties of office.
- iv) Advocate for the development and growth of golf worldwide.
- v) Perform such other tasks and duties as are delegated to the President by the Board.

3. Expenses:

The President shall not be entitled to any payment, other than the reimbursement of expenses incurred relative to this office and its duties.

4. Review of the Role

The Board will review this Role Description from time to time to provide assurance that it remains consistent with the IGF's objectives and responsibilities. The Board approves the Role Description.
