## Australia Wins the 2002 Women's Championship

In the closest finish in history, Australia made up a three-stroke deficit and won by tiebreaker over Thailand its first title since 1978 at the 20th Women's World Amateur Team Championship. The Championship was played at Saujana Golf & Country Club in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, and was hosted by the Malaysian Golf Association.

"It's unbelievable," said Australian captain Liz Cavill. "I thought we could do it. The team is just so talented. They ground it out very hard. It's a dream for us all."

With two of three players' scores counting each day, both teams finished 72 holes at 6-under-par 578 on the par-73 Palm and Bunga Raya Courses at Saujana.

The Australian team, led by Lindsey Wright (72) and Katherine Hull (73), shot 1-under-par 145 on the Palm Course the final day. The tiebreaker, however, was awarded to the Australians because

their third player's score the final day was lower than that of Thailand's third player. This came from Vicky Uwand, who shot 5-over-par 78 compared to an 8-over-par 81 from Titiya Plucksataporn.

Wright and Hull, who are teammates at Pepperdine University in California, USA, helped Australia move steadily up the standings during each day of the championship.

Going into the fourth round, Thailand, with excellent play from 16-year-old American-based identical twins, Naree and Aree Song Wongluekiet, led by one stroke over Spain and by three over Australia and Germany but could not maintain the lead they held for the first

After placing 20th on the first day, the Aussies moved into fifth with a 6-under-par performance on the second day. They climbed again on the third day with a 5-under-par score and were tied for third.

"When we were standing at tied for third, there was only one place to go and that was to one," said Cavill, who played in the Espirito Santo three times for Australia.

Thailand, which was seeking to become the seventh wire-to-wire winner, was playing in just its third championship, with a best finish of 18th in its debut in 1984. Aree posted a 1-under-par 72 and her sister, Naree, registered a 3-over-par

76 in the final round.

"This week it was the battle of the mentally tough," said Hull of Australia. "With the heat and courses being so difficult, it comes down to the mental game. We decided to gut it out and it paid off."

Aree Song Wongluekiet agreed

that it was a grueling week with four days of practice and four days of competition.

"I didn't feel like we lost," said A. Song Wongluekiet. "Everyone on our team played consistently. It was hot and it was a long week. The club got heavy at the end and the hills were getting steep, but I am proud of the way we played."

Spain, which entered the final day a stroke behind Thailand, finished third at 5-under-par 579. Germany placed fourth at 3-under-par 581. The USA team was fifth at even-par 584, its 19th top-five finish in 20 events. Defending champion France finished tied for 15th at 13-over-par 597.

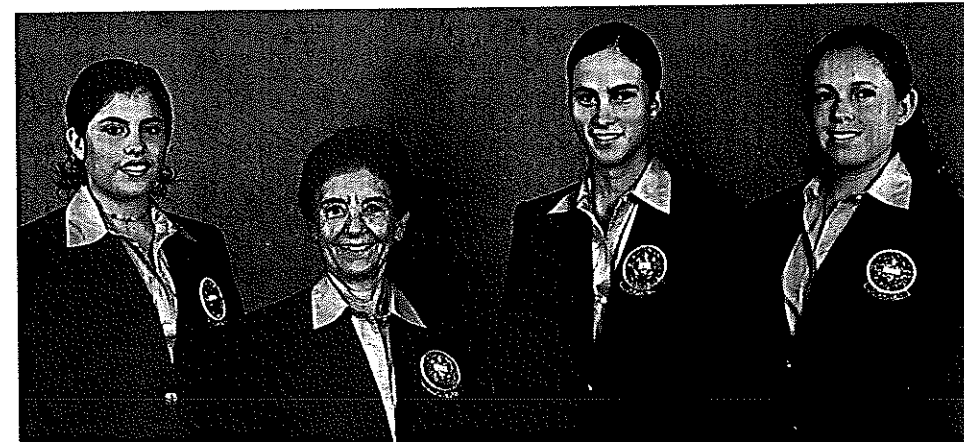

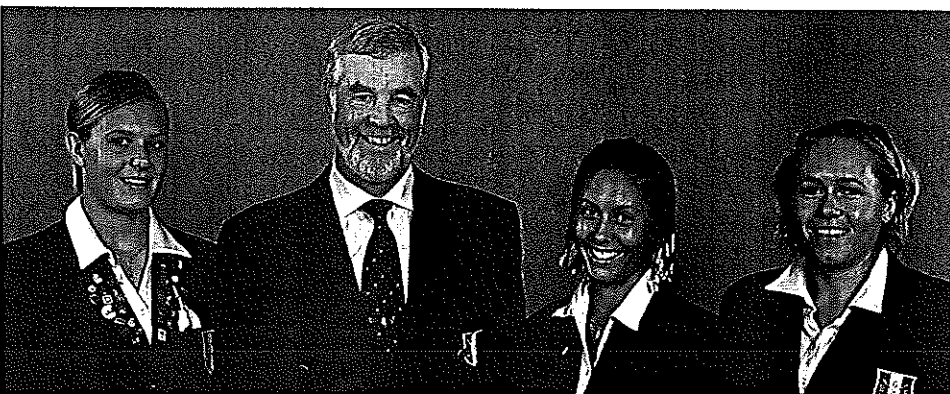

## United States Wins the 2002 Men's Championship

Bolstered by a 6-under-par 66 from D.J. Trahan on the final day, the USA won the 23rd World Amateur Team Championship by three strokes over France at Saujana Golf & Country Club, in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The Championship was hosted by the Malaysian Golf Association.

"That was as fine a round of golf as you will see at the amateur level," said USA captain O. Gordon Brewer Jr. of Trahan's round that included five birdies, a bogey and an eagle. "He picked the team up on his shoulders."

The USA recorded a four-day total of 8-under-par 568 and made a successful defense of the Eisenhower Trophy, which it won for a record 12th time. Trahan, who was 2-under-par after nine holes, eagled the par-5 13th hole and then finished with birdies on the 17th and 18th holes.

For the champions, 2002 U.S. Amateur champion Ricky Barnes shot 2-over-par 74 and helped the USA register a 4-under-par total of 140 on the final day.

Trahan's 66 tied for the lowest individual round of the championship (with Edoardo Molinari of Italy in the third round) and was the second-lowest final round in 23 playings of the championship.

France began the final round with a three-stroke lead over the USA.

"We are disappointed but we are very proud for our country and our game in this championship and under this pressure," said Raphaël Pellicioli of France, the 2002 European Amateur champion.

The French runner-up finish was their highest in 23 appearances in the championship, with a third place ranking

The USA had jumped out to a 5-stroke advantage after the first day on a 5-under-par 68 from 2002 U.S. Amateur runner-up Hunter Mahan and a 3-under-par 69 from Barnes. Despite dropping five shots to par in the second round, they were still tied for the lead with France.

In round three, the French used a 68 from Pellicioli and a 71 from Grégory Bourdy, to put themselves into a three-shot lead, but could not halt the USA charge in the final round

Australia and the Philippines tied for third place at 2-under-par 574 followed by Austria and New Zealand, who were joint fifth at 1-under-par 574.

Heavy early morning rain and lightning activity on the last day forced a change in the championship format.

Invoking a condition of play, the IGF Championship Committee decided to implement a cut following the third round and limited play in the fourth round to the leading 20 teams. Play started at the 1st and 10th tees of the Palm Course only.

All teams in positions 21-63 did not play a fourth round and their final positions were determined by their total scores after 54 holes.

"The IGF Championship Committee regrets that it was not possible for all teams to complete 72 holes," said IGF Joint Secretary Peter Dawson. "But, this decision was made in view of the weather forecast and the need to concentrate maintenance resources on one course."

The best individual score of the week was from Marcus Fraser of Australia, who shot 7-under-par 281.

## ARTICLES OF THE INTERNATIONAL GOLF FEDERATION

### ARTICLE I

The name of this council is THE INTERNATIONAL GOLF FEDERATION.

### ARTICLE II

#### Object

#### Section 1. Friendship and Sportsmanship through Golf

To encourage the International development of golf and to foster friendship and sportsmanship among the peoples of the world through the conduct biennially of Amateur Team Championships for the Eisenhower Trophy and the Espirito Santo Trophy.

#### Section 2. Olympic Games

To promote golf as an Olympic sport and to act as the Federation for golf in the Olympic Games.

#### Section 3. Rules of Golf

The Championship shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and The United States Golf Association.

### ARTICLE III

#### Membership

#### Section 1. Eligibility

Membership in the Federation is open to:

The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and The United States Golf Association, as the governing bodies of the Rules of Golf and the Rules of Amateur Status; and

Any organization which is the National Federation, Association or Union responsible for amateur golf activities in its country; and observes the Rules of Golf and the Rules of Amateur Status of either The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews or The United States Golf Association.

#### Section 2. Election

An application for membership shall be supported by copies of the applicant's constitution and by-laws or similar documents and such other data as the Administrative Committee determines.

An applicant may be elected to Membership by the Federation after determination by the Administrative Committee that the requirements for membership have been met.

#### Section 3. Finances

(a) Member Organizations shall pay annual dues, as shall be determined by the Federation, payable in January of each year in the currency of the country in which the Federation's Administrative Office is located - see Article IX, Section 8 - unless prohibited by law or government regulation.

(b) Income from dues shall be used to defray all Federation expenses. If expenses in a given year result in a deficit in the Federation's account, which shall be maintained in the Administrative Office, the deficit shall be shared by those

Expenses of the Federation shall be limited to the following:

(1) Cost of Administration including staff, office rent, stationery, postage, printing and other communications incurred by the Administrative Office.

(2) Expenses including travel and hotel accommodation authorized by the Administrative Committee.

(3) Insurance and maintenance of the Championship trophies; and

(4) Provision of prizes

No Member Organization may incur any expense for the Federation, and no representative of the Federation shall have authority to incur any expense except as expressly stated herein.

(c) Any other expense incident to the affairs of the Federation shall be borne by the Member Organization whose representative incurs such expense.

(d) The expense of conducting the Championship shall be borne by the Member Organization entertaining it.

#### Section 4. Obligations and Discipline

The acceptance of membership in the Federation shall bind each Member Organization to uphold all the provisions of these Articles and any rules or actions of the Federation or the Administrative Committee.

Any Member Organization failing in these obligations or ceasing to meet the eligibility requirements may be suspended or expelled by the Federation.

#### Section 5. Correspondence with Member Organizations

A Member Organization shall not circulate a memorandum to all other Member Organizations without approval of the Administrative Committee.

#### Section 6. Withdrawal

Any Member Organization may withdraw from membership by notifying the Administrative Office to that effect.

Any Member Organization so withdrawing shall remain obligated for its annual dues for the year in which withdrawal occurred.

### ARTICLE IV

#### Championship

#### Section 1. Time

The Championship shall be held biennially, on such dates as the Federation shall determine. Normally, the Championship shall be held in the last two weeks of September or the first two weeks in October.

#### Section 2. Place

(a) The Championship shall be rotated among the three following Zones in the order stated:

(1) Asia-Pacific Zone - Countries of Asia, Australia, New Zealand and Oceania.

(2) American Zone - Countries of North America, the Caribbean



(3) European-African Zone — Countries of Europe, Africa and the Middle East.

(b) Invitations to entertain the Championship shall be submitted by Member Organizations to the Administrative Office at least nine months in advance of the Biennial Meeting immediately preceding. The Administrative Office shall inform all Member Organizations of such invitations at least one month in advance of the Meeting.

(Note: Invitations may be submitted by any Member Organization in any Zone. Although invitations from the appropriate Zone will, of course, be given first consideration, it is important that invitations from other Zones, particularly the Zone next in order, should be available in case no invitation acceptable to the Federation has been received from the appropriate Zone. If no suitable venue is available in the appropriate Zone, invitations from other Zones shall be submitted at least three months in advance of the Biennial Meeting.)

At the time of submitting its invitation the Member Organization shall represent that, subject to any restrictions imposed upon it by the Government of its country, it will allow all other Member Organizations to compete if its invitation is accepted. It shall also present with its invitation a statement from a properly authorized official of the Government of its country that all Member Organizations, other than those (if any) named in the statement, will be allowed to visit the country and to compete in the Championship without any restriction whatsoever.

At a time not more than eight months and not less than seven months from the first of the month in which the Championship is to take place, both the Member Organization and a properly authorized official of the Government of its country shall reiterate the statement made in the paragraph above.

Championship invitations shall not be issued and pertinent advertising/promotion shall not be engaged in more than 33 years in advance.

(c) The location of each Championship shall normally be determined by the Federation at its Biennial Meeting immediately preceding. In reaching its decision the Federation shall have regard to:

(1) The importance of locating the Championship in the appropriate Zone in accordance with Section 2(a) of this Article; and

(2) The degree (if any) to which an invitation to entertain the Championship has been restricted by the Government of the country concerned.

If no invitation acceptable to the Federation has been received from within the appropriate Zone, the Federation may consider and accept any invitation which may have been received from within the Zone next in order of rotation.

However, if the Federation at its Biennial Meeting is unable, due to a lack of acceptable invitations or for any other reason, finally to decide the location of the next Championship, the Administrative Committee shall take such steps as are necessary to ensure the continuance of the Championship.

(d) The Federation shall have the power to waive the annual dues of any Member Organization which, owing to a restriction

## ARTICLE V Amateur Team Championship

### Section 1. Entry Dates

Each Member Organization shall inform the Administrative Office biennially as to whether or not it will enter the Championship; such notification shall reach the Administrative Office not later than six months before the Championship. Later entries may be accepted if the Administrative Committee and the Member Organization entertaining the Championship approves.

Each Member Organization which enters the Championship shall inform the Administrative Office of the personnel of its Team not later than one month before the Championship. Substitutions may be made at any subsequent time at the pleasure of the Member Organization.

The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews shall not be entitled to enter a team from Great Britain & Ireland in any year in which teams are entered by the Golf Unions of England, Ireland, Scotland, and Wales.

### Section 2. Qualification of Players; Amateur Status

The players comprising each Team shall be:

(a) Amateur golfers under the Rules of Amateur Status of either The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews or The United States Golf Association; and

(b) Citizens of the country of the Member Organization represented, except that in cases where a Team of citizens would be impracticable, players normally resident in the country may be included.

A player with dual nationality who has played for one country in a Championship may, in the immediately following Championship, play for the other country of which he is a citizen, provided he has been a citizen of the other country for at least one year.

Each Team shall have a Captain, who may be either a player or a non-player.

### Section 3. Form of Play

(a) Prior to the date for closing of entries, the Joint Secretaries shall determine the maximum number of Teams, using two courses, which can be accepted at the selected venue. At the date of closing of entries, if the number of Teams entered does not exceed the maximum acceptable number, the Teams will consist of two or three players. If the number of Teams entered exceeds the maximum acceptable, then the Administrative Committee shall determine a revised format for the Championship, as it considers appropriate.

(b) The Championship shall consist of 72 holes stroke play; 18 holes each on four consecutive days of the Championship period. All the players of each Team shall be eligible for all four rounds; disqualification of a player under the Rules of Golf in any round shall not be effective for any subsequent round unless the Administrative Committee determines otherwise.

The Administrative Committee shall determine the starting times for each country and if two courses are used, the course on which each country plays. They shall also determine the method by which the countries are divided between the two

players of each Team shall constitute the Team score for that round.

The total of the two-player Team scores for the four rounds shall be the Team's score for the Championship.

The Champion shall be the Team with the lowest such total score for 72 holes.

(c) Prior to the start of every Championship, the Administrative Committee shall decide the procedure to be adopted in the event of a tie.

### Section 4. Prizes

(a) The Eisenhower Trophy, presented to the Federation by friends of golf in the United States through The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and The United States Golf Association, shall be held for the ensuing biennium by the Member Organization whose Team is the winner.

(b) A uniform type of prize for individuals shall be awarded to the players and the Captain of the winning Team, the second-place Team and the third-place Team.

(c) No other prizes may be accepted from any source, except symbolic gifts by a Member Organization to its Team.

### Section 5. Championship Committee; Course Unplayable

(a) Prior to a Championship, the Administrative Committee shall appoint a Championship Committee to conduct the event. The host Member Organization shall be represented on the Championship Committee.

(b) The Championship Committee shall be authorized to decide when a Championship course is unplayable.

(c) If a Championship course is declared unplayable and as a result it is not possible to complete 72 holes of play in the period in which the Championship is scheduled, the Championship shall not be extended beyond the last scheduled day and the winner shall be the Team which returns the lowest score for the number of stipulated rounds played, except that, if it is not possible to play at least 36 holes in the four scheduled days, the Championship shall be terminated without a Champion being determined.

(d) The Championship Committee shall be authorized to schedule in advance a round of less than 18 holes, i.e., the Committee shall be authorized to declare before play begins on any day that the stipulated round for that day shall be, for example, nine holes; the Committee shall not be authorized to declare during play of a round that the stipulated round for that day shall be, for example, nine holes if the stipulated round when play began was to be 18 holes.

## ARTICLE VI Arrangements for Championship

The Member Organization entertaining the Championship shall have the honor of and be responsible for planning and arranging for the Championship, subject to the applicable provisions of these Articles and approval by the Administrative Committee, and for all the expenses in connection therewith except the expenses of the Teams. Such Member Organization may charge admission to spectators and otherwise raise income for its maintenance and any excess of the proceeds over the

No financial liability shall attach to either the Federation or to any Member Organization other than the Member Organization entertaining the Championship.

## ARTICLE VII Expenses of Teams

Each Member Organization shall be responsible for the expenses of its Team's players and Captain.

## ARTICLE VIII Federation Meetings

### Section 1. Biennial Meeting

The Federation shall meet biennially on the day before the start of the Championship and at the place of the Championship.

At a Biennial Meeting of the Federation each Member Organization shall be entitled to be represented by one Delegate, who shall be a citizen or normally a resident of the country of the Member Organization, and who shall be present at the Meeting in person. Appointment of Delegates shall be certified to the Administrative Office in advance.

### Section 2. Quorum

Twelve Member Organizations represented by Delegates present in person shall constitute a quorum at a Biennial Meeting of the Federation.

### Section 3. Action Without Meeting

Between Biennial Meetings, the Federation may take action by mail vote on resolutions submitted to the Member Organizations by the Administrative Office pursuant to direction of the Administrative Committee.

### Section 4. Majority Decision

A majority vote of the Delegates at a Biennial Meeting of the Federation at which a quorum is present, or a majority vote of the Member Organizations in cases of action by mail, shall determine any question before the Federation, subject to any additional requirements of other provisions of these Articles.

## ARTICLE IX Administrative Committee

### Section 1. Composition

There shall be an Administrative Committee of 15 persons, composed of the Chairman of the Women's Committee and 14 other persons representing 12 Member organizations; four Member Organizations in each of the three respective Zones shall be represented, with at least one of the Member Organizations in the European-African Zone being from the Continent of Africa. Each such person shall be a citizen or normally a resident of the country of the Member Organization he/she represents. Any country entertaining a future Championship that is not represented in the Administrative Committee shall be entitled to one representative to serve on the Committee in a non-voting capacity.

### Section 2. Nomination; Election

(a) The Administrative Committee shall serve as a Nominating Committee and shall propose to the Biennial Meeting 10

Additional nominations may be made by Delegates to the Biennial Meeting.

(b) At each Biennial Meeting 10 Member Organizations shall be chosen, by ballot, to receive the right to appoint one representative (or substitute) each to the Administrative Committee, to serve for the ensuing two years. The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and The United States Golf Association shall be permanently entitled to appoint two representatives.

(c) Each Member Organization so chosen shall promptly appoint its representative to the Administrative Committee and give the Administrative Office notification of the appointment. If a Delegate of any Member Organization so chosen is present at the Biennial Meeting, he shall thereupon become the appointee of his Member Organization to the Administrative Committee.

(d) A Member Organization shall have the right to change its appointee to the Administrative Committee, any such change shall become effective when the Administrative Office receives notification thereof.

### Section 3. Duties

The Administrative Committee shall conduct the affairs of the Federation, subject to the provisions of these Articles and to directions of the Federation.

### Section 4. Meetings

The retiring Administrative Committee shall meet immediately prior to the Biennial Meeting of the Federation.

The Administrative Committee newly determined at the Biennial Meeting of the Federation shall meet immediately after the Biennial Meeting of the Federation.

### Section 5. Quorum

Four members present in person representing at least six Member Organizations shall constitute a quorum of the Administrative Committee.

### Section 6. Action Between Meetings

Between meetings, the Administrative Committee may take action by mail vote on resolutions submitted to the representatives to the Administrative Committee by the Administrative Office.

### Section 7. Majority Decision

A majority vote at a meeting at which a quorum is present, or a majority vote of the entire Administrative Committee in case of action by mail, shall determine any question before the Administrative Committee.

### Section 8. Administrative Office

The Federation's Administrative Office is located at Golf House, Far Hills, N.J., USA. The Administrative Office shall keep the records of the Federation and of the Administrative Committee, give notices of all meetings and conduct all votes by mail, carry on the correspondence of the Federation, and perform all other customary duties.

## ARTICLE X

### Officers

#### Section 1. Titles; Election

The officers of the Federation shall be two Joint Chairmen, who shall be representatives of and appointed by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and The United States Golf Association, and two Joint Secretaries. The Joint Chairmen shall each be one of the representatives to the Administrative Committee. The Joint Secretaries shall be appointed by the Administrative Committee.

#### Section 2. Chairman

One of the Joint Chairmen shall preside at meetings of the Federation and of the Administrative Committee, and in general shall perform the customary duties of his office.

## ARTICLE XI

### Language

The official language of the Federation is English.

## ARTICLE XII

### Care of Trophy

#### Section 1. Protection

The United States Golf Association shall retain title to the Championship Trophy, and shall make arrangements for its insurance and for its safekeeping during any suspension of the Championship.

#### Section 2. Dissolution of Federation

In the event of dissolution of the Federation, such use or other disposition of the Championship Trophy shall be made as The United States Golf Association may in its discretion determine.

## ARTICLE XIII

### Amendments

These Articles may be amended by action of the Federation, provided, however, that the provisions of these Articles with respect to the Rules of Golf and the Rules of Amateur Status shall not be amended without the unanimous affirmative vote of the Member Organizations; that the provisions of these Articles with respect to permanent representation to the Administrative Committee shall not be amended without the affirmative votes of the respective Member Organizations concerned; and that the provisions of these Articles with respect to the ownership and custody of the Championship Trophy shall not be amended without the affirmative vote of The United States Golf Association.

## ARTICLE XIV

### Women's Amateur Team Championship

#### Section 1. Regulations

The Federation shall conduct biennially a Women's Amateur Team Championship for the Espirito Santo Trophy, open to Teams representing Member Organizations of the Women's Division.

All relevant provisions and principles of Articles IV, V, VI, VII and XII shall apply.

#### Section 2. Place and Time

The place and the time of the Women's Amateur Team Championship shall be determined by the Federation. The Championship shall be held as near as feasible geographically to the Men's Championship and in an adjacent week or concurrently but preferably before the Men's Championship.

#### Section 3. Prizes

The Espirito Santo Trophy, presented to the Federation by the family of Ricardo Espirito Santo through the Portuguese Golf Federation, shall be held for the ensuing biennium by the Member Organization whose Team is the winner.

In the event of abandonment of the Women's Amateur Team Championship, such use or other disposition of the Espirito Santo Trophy shall be made as the Portuguese Golf Federation may in its discretion determine.

## ARTICLE XV

### Women's Division

All relevant provisions and principles of the Articles shall apply to the Women's Division except as follows:

#### Section 1. Membership

Membership in the Women's Division is open to any organization which either:

(a) Is a Member Organization of the Federation and has jurisdiction of women's amateur golf in its country. An application from a Member Organization of the Federation for membership in the Women's Division shall be granted automatically.

- OR -

(b) Is responsible for women's amateur golf in its country and observes the Rules of Golf and the Rules of Amateur Status of either The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews or The United States Golf Association. An application from such an organization shall be supported by copies of the applicant's constitution and by-laws or similar documents and such data as the Administrative Committee determines. Such an applicant may be elected by the Federation after determination by the Administrative Committee that the requirements for membership have been met.

#### Section 2. Finances

The principles of Article III, Section 3, shall apply to Women's Division Members to defray all Federation expenses relating to women's events.

#### Section 3. Biennial Meeting

The Women's Division shall meet biennially two days before the start of the Women's Amateur Team Championship and at the place of the Championship.

At a Biennial Meeting each Member Organization of the Women's Division shall be entitled to be represented by one Delegate, who shall be present in person and whose appointment shall be certified to the Administrative Office in advance.

Eight Member Organizations of the Women's Division represented by Delegates present in person shall constitute a quorum at a Biennial Meeting.

#### Section 4. Women's Committee; Chairman Women's Committee

There shall be a Women's Committee of 11 persons, composed of the Chairman of the Women's Division and the Women's Committee, and 10 other persons representing 10 Member Organizations. Three Member Organizations in each of the respective Zones will be represented, along with an additional representative from the continent of Africa. Any country entertaining a future Championship that is not represented in the Women's Committee shall be entitled to one representative to serve on the Committee in a non-voting capacity.

At each Biennial Meeting there shall be chosen, by ballot, the nine Member Organizations which shall be entitled to appoint representatives to the Women's Committee, to serve for the ensuing two years.

#### Chairman

A woman from the appropriate Zone shall be chosen by ballot to serve as Chairman of the Women's Division and the Women's Committee for up to a maximum of six years. The Member Organization of the Chairman shall be entitled to two representatives, including the Chairman.

The Chairman shall be chosen among the three Zones on a rotational basis.

#### Section 5. Duties of Women's Committee

The Women's Committee shall conduct the affairs of the Women's Division, subject to directions of the Federation, and shall advise the Federation on matters relative to the Women's Amateur Team Championship. Matters of policy shall be determined by the Federation.
